Information regarding Marksheets

Franziska, who is in charge of the tabbing, has following requests:

- If there are only two judges in a debate, one of the judges must act as chief adjudicator, the judge with the most experience in the room will act as chief adjudicator.
 The chief adjudicator's vote counts double. The chief adjudicator must write the letters "CA" in the top right-hand corner of the marksheet.
- 2. Please make sure that your arithmetic is correct!
- 3. Write down both the name of the winning team and their side. (e.g. "Prop, School XYZ")
- 4. Please give the marksheets to the person responsible for your venue (in most cases the coach of the hosting team)
- 5. Hosts, please make sure you have all marksheets from all debates.
- 6. Please make scans or copies of the marksheets for safety purposes and post the originals to Franziska. The scans are will only be needed in case the originals get lost. Franziska's address is
